2. Eventhough, this facility has been made available from July 2012, it is noticed that, so far, few persons have utilised this facility.

3. Hence, it is hereby informed that the **online filing of Goods Registration is being made mandatory w.e.f. 03.10.2018 in this Commissionerate.** Hence, all Exporters/Customs Brokers are requested to follow the message guidelines available in [www.icegate.gov.in](http://www.icegate.gov.in) and the advisory of ICEGATE issued in this regard to the Trade (Copy enclosed).

4. Difficulty faced in this regard, if any, may be brought to the notice of this office.

## Advisory

### Starting of Goods Registration Message (CACHE05) through ICEGATE

#### General:

- Attention of trade (Customs House Agent/ Exporters) is invited to the fact that the Customs is going to initiate the filing of Goods Registration Message through ICEGATE from 16.07.2012.
- So far, these details (popularly known as Anex\_C details) were fed by the designated officer (INSPECTOR) at the time of goods arrival in the System. However, this message (message ID CACHE05) is being started through ICEGATE to capture the details from the Trade Partner (Customs House Agent/ Exporters) who are best placed to provide this information correctly and officer shall only verify the details and confirm/ Modify the information before their integration into the system.
- The appropriate stage of the message is the post confirmation of Cargo Arrival with the custodian but the message (CACHE05) information received prior to this stage would also be accepted by ICEGATE/ ICES and remain available in the system. However, it shall be integrated only after confirmation of the cargo arrival by the custodian, wherever the Cargo Arrival (CARR) message is made online with the custodians.

#### TESTING:

The starting of this message is expected to facilitate the trade as well as reduce the errors in EGM reconciliation. NIC shall release the new version of the RES Package shortly. The Trade (Customs House Agent/ Exporters) is advised to test this message (for users of RES packages other than NIC RES package) in PRE-Production environment in consultation with their site system manager. For testing, first a SB is to be filed in Pre- Production and after the generation of the SB Number, the Annexure C Details can be filed through message. For Pre-production filing, the mails with test files of fresh SB and the CACHE05 message may be addressed to [Icegate.Test@icegate.gov.in](mailto:Icegate.Test@icegate.gov.in)

- Trade (Customs House Agent/ Exporters) is advised to initiate the registration for filing this message through ICEGATE by sending emails to ICEGATE helpdesk at email id [registration@icegate.gov.in](mailto:registration@icegate.gov.in) for including this message in their already registered profile.
- Trade (Customs House Agent/ Exporters) is also advised to initiate the development of this message, if they are not using the NIC RES in order to file it through ICEGATE. ## Advisory (for Officers)

### Starting of Goods Registration Message (CACHE05) through ICEGATE

#### General:

- Attention is invited to the fact that the Customs is going to initiate the filing of Goods Registration Message through ICEGATE from 16.07.2012.
- So far, these details (popularly known as Annex\_C details) were fed by the designated officer (INSPECTOR) at the time of goods arrival in the System. However, this message (message ID CACHE05) is being started through ICEGATE to capture the details from the Trade Partner (Customs House Agent/ Exporters) who are best placed to provide this information correctly
- The appropriate stage of the message is the post confirmation of Cargo Arrival with the custodian but the information received prior to this stage would also be accepted by ICES and available in the system. However, it shall be available to officer for integration only after confirmation of the cargo arrival by the custodian, wherever the Cargo Arrival (CARR) message is online with the custodians.
- The officer shall only verify the details and confirm/ modify the information before their integration into the system.
- In respect of the cargo where this message is not filed online, the appropriate officer will have to still feed the Annex\_C details in the system, as was being done earlier.

#### IMPORTANT NOTE

- Trade (Customs House Agent/ Exporters) shall be advised to initiate the registration for filing this message through ICEGATE by sending emails to ICEGATE helpdesk at email id [registration@icegate.gov.in](mailto:registration@icegate.gov.in) for including this message in their already registered profile.
- The Officer shall hereinafter discourage the trade request to enter Annex-C information into the system, in case SB was filed online. NIC RES is developed and available for download.
- Trade (Customs House Agent/ Exporters) shall also be advised to initiate the development of this message, if they are not using the NIC RES in order to file it through ICEGATE.
