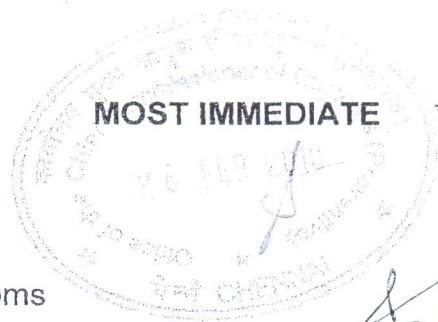

Subject: Review of prices of essential commodities – reg.

Sir / Madam,

I am directed to inform that the Government is reviewing the prices of essential commodities especially on an ongoing basis.

2. The Government have already initiated necessary control and other measures on the supply and demand side to increase the availability of essential commodities like sugar. Department of Food & Public Distribution have indicated that there are reports of sugar being smuggled across the borders, which needs to be curbed. In view of this, there is a need to maintain greater vigil at customs points to prevent smuggling of sugar.

3. It is requested that all officers under your charge may be suitably alerted / instructed to remain vigilant to prevent smuggling of sugar at customs points.
